Parents, Read This!

Lies spoken in God's Name.

Conversations with God and *Conversations with God for Teens*, written by Neale D. Walsch, and are sold to school children through The Scholastic Book Club, sound harmless enough, but they make truth of the statement, "Don't judge a book by its cover (or title)!"

Why are we concerned? The author purports to answer various questions asked by kids using the "voice of God." However, the "answers" that he gives are not Bible-based and go against the very infallible word of God. It is frightening that someone would be bold enough to write from God's point of view contrary to what He has written in His Word.

For instance, (I paraphrase), when a girl asks the question, "Why am I a lesbian?", his answer is that she was "born that way" because of genetics, (just as you were born right-handed, with brown eyes, etc.). Then he tells her to go out and "celebrate" her differences.

Another girl poses the question, "I am living with my boyfriend. My parents say that I should marry him because I am living in sin. Should I marry him?" His reply is, "Who are you sinning against? Not me, because you have done nothing wrong."

Another question asks about God's forgiveness of sin. His reply, "I do not forgive anyone because there is nothing to forgive... There is no such thing as right or wrong and that is what I have been trying to tell everyone. Do not judge people. People have chosen to judge one another and this is wrong, because the rule is "Judge not, lest ye be judged."

Besides the Scholastic Book Club, these books are being promoted on TV. Both have been on the New York Times best-sellers list.

Our adversary, the devil, roams about as a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. I Peter 5:8. Remember, lions like to hunt for the weakest and the youngest of its prey. Parents, **protect your children.**
