Peter and Rachel Shirokov serve with Chosen People Ministries and are supported monthly by the Adult 6 S.S. class at Hermon Baptist Church. Their ministry is to reach out to the Russian Jewish community in Atlanta, Georgia. Chosen People Ministries exists to pray for, evangelize, disciple, and serve Jewish people everywhere and to help fellow believers do the same. The mission was founded in Brooklyn, New York in 1894 by Rabbi Leopold Cohn, a Hungarian Jewish immigrant with zeal to share the knowledge of Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah with God's chosen people.

Today, Chosen People Ministries serves in thirteen countries around the globe. Their outreach programs include evangelism and discipleship, Messianic Centers and congregations, equipping the local church for Jewish evangelism, print and web publications, and benevolence work.



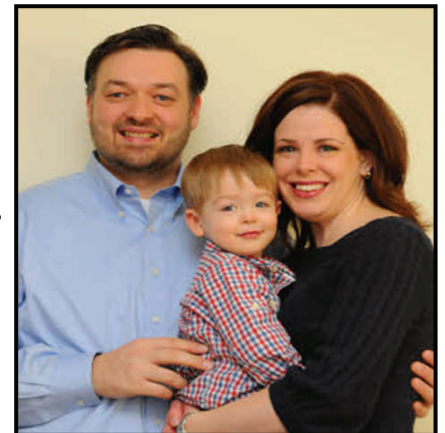

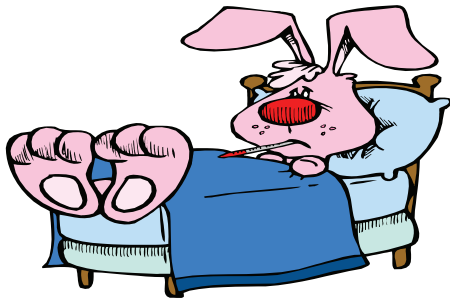
